Description: Book of prayers and rites used by the Priest during Mass.

Description: Metal vessel covered with a lid, used to repose the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle.

Description: Special sink in the sacristy, to the right of the regular sink. Its pipes lead directly into the ground.
